The Parksafe car park in Bold Lane in Derby will continue being operated by the award-winning, high security company Parksafe Systems Ltd for another 8 years in a new contract signed with Derby City Council last week.

The agreement marks the start of an extensive refurbishment and development programme which will commence in January 2010 for an intensive 24 week period and be completed in June.
